Growing Conditions

We planted these Pinot Gris vines in the 1990s, in 3 different blocks in our East Kelowna Slopes vineyard. Deeply rooted, these now older vines are well adapted to the site, accessing mineral nutrition from layers in the soil.

Winemaking

Pinot Gris whole clusters and stemmed grapes fermented with wild yeast, and underwent wild malolactic conversion, taking sugars and malic acid to complete dryness. We pressed the must and let it settle, rather than fining or filtering, and did not ameliorate with additives such as sulphites. It is not an expression of a vessel, but a savory expression of the complete Pinot Gris grape adapted themselves over 20 years to our site.

Food Pairing

Drink with veggie dogs, creamy grits, and mounds of collard greens. Pairs well with strongly flavoured savoury dishes.
